

King Mongkut Chaokhunthahan Hospital (KMCH)



Description

King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang (KMITL) provides comprehensive healthcare infrastructure to ensure the physical and mental well-being of all students, faculty, and staff members. The campus is equipped with a fully operational hospital that offers both general medical care and specialized treatment.

In addition to the hospital, KMITL houses a university clinic and a dental service center, both of which are accessible to students and staff for preventive, routine, and emergency care. Furthermore, every faculty has a designated First Aid point, ensuring rapid response to minor injuries or urgent health needs within academic areas.

To build a culture of preparedness and safety, the university organizes annual first-aid training programs for staff and emergency personnel. These trainings improve the community's capacity to respond effectively to medical emergencies.

Moreover, the university leverages a digital platform that includes a GIS-based campus map showing the locations of AED stations, emergency medical points, and other relevant health and safety infrastructure. This system enhances accessibility, awareness, and quick decision-making during medical incidents.
